This is in response to your letter to the OSHA Directorate of Training and Education dated October 25, 2010, requesting an update on FOIA #621346 regarding "all documents that refer to, reflect or mention communications discussing the selection of OSHA's 2010 Susan Harwood Grant Awardees," and "all documents reflecting any meeting, phone call, email, letter or other communication including handwritten communications regarding the selection of OSHA 2010 Susan Harwood Grant Awardees," and "all evaluations used in determining the selection of OSHA's 2010 Harwood Awardees."

Please note that OSHA originally received two identical FOIA requests from the Americans for Limited Government. OSHA deleted FOIA #621346. Your request is now being processed as FOIA #622027.

The Directorate of Training and Education is currently in the process of collecting the requested documents. The receipt of this letter does not mean that your request for records has been granted. Processing your FOIA request includes rendering an Agency decision as to whether or not to grant, partially grant, or deny your request according to the FOIA and its statutory exemptions, and other Federal statutes and requirements. Given the scope of your request, it is anticipated that the collection and evaluation of the documents, as well as the eventual determination regarding the release of the documents will be completed in approximately three weeks from the date of this letter.
