I. Theme: Restoring Accountability

EBSA believes that most of its regulatory agenda initiatives support the Department's establishment of new accountability standards for both employee benefit plan sponsors and service providers to such plans. Specifically examples include:

- A regulation (interim-final) establishing new accountability standards for plan service providers through enhanced disclosure of plan and investment-related fees and expense to fiduciaries of pension plans. RIN 1210-AB08
- 2. A regulation (proposal) establishing new accountability standards for plan service providers through enhanced disclosure of plan and investment-related fees and expense to fiduciaries of welfare plans. RIN [NEW]
- 3. A regulation (final) establishing new accountability standards for plan sponsors through enhanced disclosure of plan and investment-related fees and expenses to participants and beneficiaries who are responsible for the investment of assets held in their individual account (e.g., 401(k)) plan. RIN 1210-AB07
- 4. A regulation (proposal) establishing new accountability standards for individuals and entities providing investment advice to employee benefit plans by amending the definition of "fiduciary" to subject all individuals in fact engaged in the provision of investment advice to ERISA's fiduciary standards. RIN 1210-AB32
- 5. 4. A regulation (final) establishing new accountability standards for individuals and entities providing investment advice to participants in individual account plans and IRA beneficiaries to ensure that provided advice is both high quality and unbiased. RIN 1210-AB35
- 6. A regulation (proposal) establishing new accountability standards for plan administrators and others responsible for the processing of employee benefit plan claims under ERISA. RIN [NEW]

II. Resources

We have reviewed the resources available to complete the Agency's responsibilities in the regulatory process, including the drafting of rules, the preparation of required economic, paperwork and other analyses attendant to such rules and concluded that we have the resources necessary to carrying out EBSA's responsibilities in accordance with the timeframes proposed in its Regulatory Agenda. We also have received assurances from the Plan Benefits Security Division that they have the resources necessary to conduct a review and clearance of EBSA's regulatory initiatives within the timeframes necessary for EBSA to satisfy its responsibilities with respect to the regulatory agenda.

Responses to your Questions: (FYI this topic came up at our agency meeting with Seth today.)

1a. The term "employee" is defined in section 3(6) of ERISA to mean "any individual employed by an employer." Whether an individual is an "employee" for purposes section 3(6) of Title I of ERISA generally requires a determination of whether there is an employer-employee relationship applying common law principles. See Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company v . Darden, 503 U.S. 318 (1992); Yates v. Hendon, 541 U.S. 1 (2004). Once an individual is determined to be an employee, entitlement to benefits can only be determined by reference to plan terms. These are facts and circumstances, individual by individual determinations.

1b. We do not believe that these issues can be addressed through a regulation.

2. We think that the ERISA issues related to independent contractor cases can be addressed by including a provision in settlement/consent agreements entered into by Wage and Hour that would require the subject employer to review and determine the benefit entitlement of affected employees and report their conclusions and remedial actions to EBSA. We would be pleased to work with WH and SOL to de /elop necessary language.
