Re: FOIA Appeal No. 120059

Dear Mr. Mehrens:

This decision is in response to your appeal dated June 15, 2011, appealing under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) the April 15, 2011, determination of Andrew Davis, Chief, Division of Interpretations and Standards, Office of Labor-Management Standards (OLMS). On March 8, 2011, Mr. William Wilson, President, Americans for Limited Government, requested a copy of "all records relating to daily schedules including attendees at meetings held by and attended by John Lund, created on or after July 1, 2009." On appeal, you seek release of information contained in 187 redactions made on 68 calendar pages that you listed in your appeal.

We obtained the calendar pages at issue and conducted a *de novo* review of the redacted information. Our review of these pages revealed that you seek all material withheld by OLMS in its initial response except entries redacted from six calendar days -- September 2, 2009, November 6, 2009, December 10, 2009, December 16, 2009, January 21, 2010, and one entry from February 16, 2010. Thus, we have reviewed all information withheld by OLMS with the exception of these six entries. After this review, we have determined that we may release additional information on 62 calendar pages. Please find these pages enclosed. Note that some of these pages retain some redactions of personal identifiers pursuant to exemption 6. We affirm all OLMS' redactions of personal identifiers made on the other six calendar pages pursuant to exemption 6. In all cases, we are withholding entries involving non-work activities of Mr. Lund, his family and his staff assistant, names of job applicants scheduled for interviews, names of employees involved in labor relations actions, and conference phone numbers and passcodes. For your convenience, newly released material is highlighted on the pages enclosed.

FOIA requires that agencies generally disclose records. Agencies may withhold requested records only if one or more of nine exemptions apply.

Exemption 6 permits the withholding of information contained in "personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6); *see also* *Painting Industry of Hawaii Market Recovery Fund v. U.S. Dep't of the Air Force*, 26 F.3d 1479, 1486 (9th Cir. 1994); *Sheet Metal Workers Int'l Ass'n v. U.S. Air Force*, 63 F.3d 994 (10th Cir. 1995); and *Painting and Drywall Work Pres. Fund, Inc. v. U.S. Dep't of Housing and Urban Dev.*, 936 F.2d 1300 (D.C. Cir. 1991). The Supreme Court has ruled that the term "similar files" encompasses any government record that concerns a particular individual; the term is not limited to records contained in personnel or medical files. *See, e.g., Dep't of State v. Washington Post*, 456 U.S. 595 (1982). Exemption 6 requires weighing the privacy interest in nondisclosure against the public interest in the release of the records. *See, e.g., Ripskis v. HUD*, 746 F.2d 1, 3 (D.C. Cir. 1984).

For a privacy interest to exist, the information must be such that there is “a substantial probability that a disclosure will cause an interference with personal privacy” and that disclosure could subject the individuals to “unwanted intrusions.” *National Association of Retired Federal Employees v. Horner*, 879 F.2d 873, 878 (D.C. Cir. 1989) (NARFE). The information withheld in this case consists of information regarding personal activities of Mr. Lund, his family and his staff assistant, names of job applicants, persons involved in labor relations actions, and conference call telephone numbers and passcodes. We find that there are privacy interests in this information.

However, the question of whether a privacy interest exists is not our only inquiry. Even if a privacy interest exists in certain information, we must disclose the information if the privacy interest is outweighed by a significant public interest. The test for determining whether a public interest sufficient to justify release of the requested information exists is whether disclosure of the information “sheds light on an agency’s performance of its statutory duties.” See *NARFE*, 879 F.2d at 879. The requestor has the burden of establishing that disclosure would serve the public interest. *Carter v. U.S. Dep’t of Commerce*, 830 F.2d 388, 391 nn.8 & 13 (D.C. Cir. 1987); see also, e.g., *National Archives and Records Administration v. Favish*, 541 U.S. 157, 172 (2004). In *U.S. Dep’t of Justice v. Reporters Committee for Freedom of the Press*, 489 U.S. 749, 776 (1989), the Supreme Court made clear that, for FOIA purposes, “public interest” is limited to the public’s right to be informed about the workings of its government. *Id.* at 773. Thus, the test for “public interest” under FOIA is not whether there is a general interest in the information, such as the type of interest that may exist in celebrities, weather events, natural disasters, or high-profile litigation. Rather, “the basic purpose of FOIA is to ensure an informed citizenry, vital to the functioning of a democratic society, needed to check against corruption and to hold the governors accountable to the governed.” *Nat’l Labor Relations Bd. v. Robbins Tire & Rubber Co.*, 437 U.S. 214, 242 (1978) (citations omitted).

In your appeal, you assert that exemption 6 should not apply to the material redacted by OLMS, because it is not appropriate to redact the names of “persons who are merely mentioned in the file;” that a name, without a connection with some other piece of personal information, does not convey a privacy interest; that a name itself does not fit the Court’s analysis of “similar file;” and that any privacy intrusion is nominal in light of the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to the public understanding of the operations or activities of the government. Thus, you advance three arguments: 1) that the material does not meet the exemption 6 threshold of information contained in “personnel and medical and similar files;” 2) that the personal information in the form of names does not in itself convey a privacy interest; and 3) even if there is a privacy interest, the balance of that interest against the public interest should lead to disclosure.

Regarding your first argument, as we discuss above, the threshold issue for invoking exemption 6 is whether the information falls with the category of “personnel and medical and similar files.” The Supreme Court has held that the phrase “similar files” should be interpreted broadly. See *U.S. Dep’t of State v. Washington Post Co.*, 456 U.S. 595 (1982). All information that “applies to a particular individual” meets the threshold requirement for exemption 6 protection. *Id.* at 601. Consequently, we find the material at issue here meets the definition of “similar file” and thus meets the threshold for exemption 6 protection.

Turning to your second argument, contrary to your assertion, courts have found that there is a protectable privacy interest in names mentioned in “personnel, medical or similar files” under exemption 6. *Sheet Metal Workers Intern. Assoc. v. U.S. Air Force*, 63 F.3d 994, 998 (10th Cir. 1995). You contend that it is not appropriate to redact a name in a calendar that is “merely mentioned,” and state that while exemption 6 supports withholding of intimate details of personal and family life, it is not intended to protect “business judgments and relationships.” We have not found a privacy interest where names in Mr. Lund’s calendar reflect only his business relationships and business activities. Rather, the names withheld on appeal are those associated with non-work activities of Mr. Lund, his family and his staff assistant, job applicants scheduled for interviews, and employees involved in labor relations actions. The privacy interest in nondisclosure under exemption 6 encompasses an individual’s control of personal information and is not limited to that of an embarrassing or intimate nature. *NARFE*, 879 F.2d at 875. Thus, we disagree that exemption 6 applies only to intimate details of personal and family life, and have found a privacy interest in names associated with non-work activities of Mr. Lund, his family, and his staff assistant. Moreover, courts have found a recognized privacy interest in the identities of persons who apply but are not selected for federal government employment, and in the names of Federal employees where public identification may conceivably subject them to harassment and annoyance. *Core v. U.S. Postal Service*, 730 F.2d 946, 948-49 (4th Cir. 1984); *Keys v. Dep’t of Homeland Security*, 570 F. Supp. 2d 59, 68 (D.D.C. 2008). We have redacted names of persons interviewed and associated with labor relations actions in order to protect these privacy interests.

Finally, in your third argument, you assert that even if a privacy interest is found, the balancing test of private versus public interests weighs toward release of the names. In our *de novo* review of the redacted information, we have considered in each instance the nature of the privacy interest and public interest in the particular information. In some instances, we agree with your argument, and in those instances, we have provided additional material and more tailored redactions than did OLMS in its initial response. Where we have released additional material to you, we have concluded that the calendar entries either did not have a privacy interest attached, or that any privacy interest attached to the entry was outweighed by the public interest in the entry’s release. Where we have affirmed a redaction and continued to withhold information, it is because we determined that the privacy interest attached to the entry outweighs any public interest in its release.

Our failure to assert any other exemption or defense that may apply in this appeal does not constitute a waiver of that exemption or defense.

This appeal decision constitutes final agency action for purposes of judicial review. The Freedom of Information Act provides for judicial review of administrative decisions denying a request in whole or in part. 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(B). You have the option of seeking judicial review of this determination by filing suit against the Department of Labor. A complainant may bring suit in the district court of the United States in the jurisdiction in which the complainant resides or has his or her principal place of business, or in which the agency records are maintained, or in the District of Columbia.
