Dear Mr. Mehrens:

This is a response to the request of Americans for Limited Government (ALG) for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).¹ It has been assigned FOIA Control No. 2012-042. ALG's request seeks records pertaining to communications to or from any Commissioner and nine named individuals associated with Google, Inc. on the topic of net neutrality. The individuals are: (1) Alan Davidson, (2) Frannie Wellings, (3) Harry Wingo, (4) Jennifer Taylor, (5) Johanna Shelton, (6) Pablo Chavez, (7) Richard Whitt, (8) Seth Webb, and (9) Will DeVries.

A search of Commission records disclosed three relevant entries on Chairman Genachowski's calendar. Other offices located no responsive records. Additional responsive records, such as ex parte notifications, are publicly available and can be found by searching the net neutrality docket in the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing system (ECFS). The three responsive calendar entries are enclosed.

ALG has been classified as a representative of the news media for purposes of determining the fee for processing its FOIA request. As such, ALG is responsible for the cost of reproducing records, except for the first 100 pages.² Because we are releasing fewer than 100 pages of material, there are no costs associated with this request.


