This is in response to your telefax, dated and received in this Office on September 12, 2012, in which you request, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), "records identifying the following information for those serving as full-time "official-time," personnel, i.e., those working full time for an exclusive representative (union) in dealing with the NLRB regarding terms and conditions of employment:

- 1. Name;
- 2. Agency or Department;
- 3. Present and past position titles and occupational series from January 20, 2012 and after;
- 4. Present and past grades from January 20, 2012 and after;
- 5. Present and past annual salary rates (including performance awards or bonuses, incentive awards, merit pay amount, Meritorious or Distinguished Executive Ranks, and allowances and differentials) from January 20, 2012 and after; and
- 6. Present and past duty stations (includes room numbers, shop designations, or other identifying information regarding buildings or places of employment).

I have enclosed a document containing the requested information.

For purposes of this request only, your request for a fee waiver has been granted. Accordingly, there is no charge for the processing of this request.

The undersigned is responsible for the above determination. You may obtain a review thereof under the provisions of the NLRB's Rules and Regulations, Section 102.117(c)(2)(v), by filing an appeal with the General Counsel, Office of Appeals, National Labor Relations Board, Washington, D.C., 20570, within 28 calendar days of the date of this letter. Thus, the appeal must be received by the close of business at 5:00 p.m. (ET) on October 24, 2012. Any
